### Assignment #1-A-----Due \_\_\_\_\_

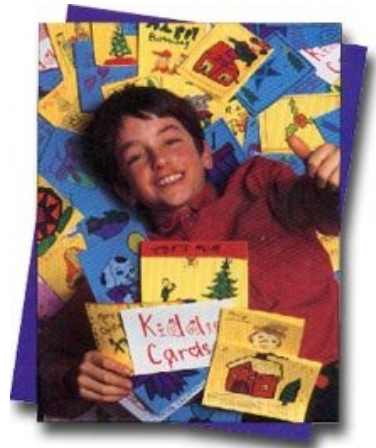
