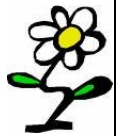

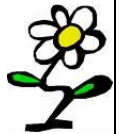

IV. What kind of homes or shelters did your tribe construct? (describe)

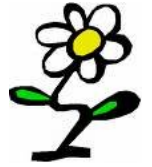

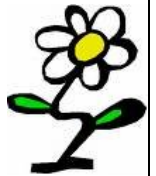
